THE WORD THIS WEEK

The readings this Sunday demonstrate that Jesus Christ cares for us as a shepherd cares for his flock. Jesus explains that he is the Good Shepherd who knows his sheep and will do anything to save them. The 4th Sunday of Easter, also known as Good Shepherd Sunday, brings together themes that are central to understanding our relationship with Jesus and our identity as Christians. We pray especially today for vocations to the priesthood, that the Lord will provide his Church with shepherds.
